**Cha Ayug si B꜋ochong – Peace Pact Celebration Songs > Closing Songs:**

The closing of the peace celebration usually takes place after two days. Before the village peace pact partners depart home, the host community declares the *Lilay*, the giving of the host community token/gifts to their village peace partners as the whole community sings a resounding joyful *Lilallilay* followed by *Lillilay* as everyone stands for the giving of gifts. The singing continues until all have expressed their best wishes of friendship and brotherhood and then the peace partners part in peaceful farewell.

*Pronunciation: y: as in «yard» / Vowels as in Spanish (short sounds of the vowels a, e, i, o and u)*
